# Executive Overview

---

In 2009, the CIBC Children's Foundation celebrated 25 years of collaboration with employees, clients and charitable organizations to improve the lives of thousands of children in Canada. CIBC Miracle Day™, which started as a simple idea among a pioneering group of CIBC Wood Gundy employees in 1984, has grown into one of the largest single-day fundraising events in Canada. The passion and commitment of CIBC employees and clients for CIBC Miracle Day have been the driving force behind 25 years of helping charitable organizations to make a difference in the lives of children.

Throughout the year, the CIBC Children's Foundation (the Foundation), contributed more than \$4 million to over 450 charities across the country. In Canada alone, over \$55 million has been raised and thoughtfully distributed since 1984.

A cornerstone of the Foundation is maintaining strong relationships with our clients and charitable partners, something that enables employees from CIBC's wholesale banking arm and CIBC Wood Gundy to understand the diverse issues affecting children. Through CIBC Miracle Day client designations, we are able to continue to support many charities at a significant annual level, which bolsters the sustainability of programs and services.

Each year, CIBC Miracle Day revenue is donated in support of hundreds of essential community programs. With a strategic focus on health, education and well-being, Miracle grants this year have supported programs that include, but are not limited to: providing opportunities for kids with disabilities to experience nature with their peers under the close care of camp specialists, enabling thousands of young people access to arts, education and athletic enrichment programs, and helping hundreds of pre-teens from inner-city, single-parent families connect with mentors that help them visualize a path to a successful future.

# Impact of CIBC Miracle Funds

---

The CIBC Children's Foundation grants funds to charities that have a record of successfully providing opportunities for children to overcome barriers and increase their potential for future success. Priority areas are education, health, and well-being for children in need who are aged thirteen and under.

## Education and Mentoring – \$938,000

Some children have unique needs that often cannot be met entirely by the school system. As a result, complimentary programs offered in communities across Canada increase the probability of academic and personal success for these kids. The CIBC Children's Foundation recognizes the influence that mentoring can have on a child's life and continues to fund after-school programs in either a one-on-one or group format. Many programs have a special focus that meets a local need, including technology, athletics, or welcoming newcomers.

Other educational initiatives that have been supported by the Foundation include anti-bullying, science, accident prevention, literacy, and anti-drug campaigns, providing children with the skills they need to cope with the pressures of their daily lives.

## Health – \$1.3 Million

Pediatric oncology treatment, rehabilitation and support services provide the essential resources many families need when their children are ill. This year, the CIBC Children's Foundation supported dozens of organizations that have developed effective programs to help families survive these challenges and, in many cases, even flourish. Programs funded include emergency financial assistance, summer camps for kids in treatment, and pediatric oncology services in local hospitals.

The Public Health Agency of Canada has identified mental health as one of the top priorities for children in Canada. Mental health issues currently affect one in six children and often present as a learning disability or anti-social behaviour that can impede development. The CIBC Children's Foundation donated over \$262,000 to group counseling programs, emergency outreach, arts-based therapy, and research programs that make it possible for parents and teachers in the public school system to identify potential problems and ensure children receive the help they need.

Rehabilitation resources for children with disabilities or chronic illness developed and delivered by our charitable partners provide much needed services for children and their families. This year, over \$320,000 was donated to programs at nationally acclaimed rehabilitation centres, community living, and specialized organizations with innovative approaches to helping kids overcome physical challenges, including equestrian training and cross-country skiing.

# In the Community

---

## Well-Being and Access to Opportunity – \$1.95 Million

Over \$1,954,000 in donations this year funded organizations that work specifically to enable children to flourish – providing opportunities that would not otherwise be available but are essential to childhood and development. The CIBC Miracle Fund, in partnership with Children's Aid, was renewed again this year, along with our support for over 158 local groups offering kids from Canada's most at-risk communities the chance to play hockey, learn to play the piano, or play with a new toy over the holiday season.

Parenting and early childhood development is supported via community centres and agencies that are only partially funded through the public budget. Without contributions from corporations and private foundations, new mothers and fathers would not have access to these important social services. In 2009, the Foundation contributed \$150,000 to enable access to drop-in centres for new parents and specialized programs that teach them how to comfort, care for, and connect with newborns and children under six years of age.

Throughout Canada, there are at least 100 agencies ensuring that kids in urban and remote communities receive at least one nutritious meal each day so that they can reach their full potential at school. The CIBC Children's Foundation has donated almost \$300,000 to several of these groups, which often work in collaboration with the public school system. Reports on breakfast programs from school staff have indicated improvements in scholastic performance, improved behaviour and attentiveness among many students.

# CIBC Miracle Day Highlights

---

Thanks to the generosity of our clients, employees and friends, the 25th anniversary of CIBC Miracle Day on December 2, 2009 was a resounding success, generating over \$3.5 million.

CIBC Wood Gundy branches across Canada achieved significant fundraising results, with a \$250,000 increase from 2008 for a total of \$1.7 million. Since the first Miracle donations in 1984, 100% of funds raised in these branches benefit the families in the community through donations to local children's charities.

The CIBC Miracle Day campaign this year was rooted in the initiative's origin and the story of the employees at a CIBC Wood Gundy branch who decided to donate their commissions for one day of business to children's charities. For over 25 years this tradition has continued with the participation of more than 2,500 employees from Investor Services, Global Equities, Investment Banking, Fixed Income, Currencies and Distribution, in addition to CIBC Wood Gundy. Individuals donate their time and effort as volunteers for CIBC Miracle Day, driving fundraising results, and often working directly with our charitable partners throughout the year.

In 2009, the 25th anniversary of CIBC Miracle Day was celebrated at events in the four major Canadian cities where CIBC's wholesale banking arm operates. In Calgary, Montreal, Toronto and Vancouver, the media gravitated to the impressive history of this corporate fundraiser and reported the positive impact we continue to have on a national scale.
