1 Sign up for Facebook

If you're already on Facebook, skip to step 2. Otherwise, you will need to sign up for Facebook:

- Go to www.facebook.com
- Sign up with your email address
- Set your preferences, e.g., English or French language
- No need to complete a full profile – it's your decision how much information you share

2 Join the group

- Go to: [facebook.com/groups/cibcretirees](https://www.facebook.com/groups/cibcretirees)
- If you're not already signed in, log in to Facebook
- Click the green 'Join Group' button beside CIBC Retirees
- Requests to join the group will be reviewed within 1 business day

Here's a few tips on how to find and post information in the group:

- 3 **Discussion** – click to see 'Recent Activity' which is a list of the most recent postings on the site, e.g., this month's retirements and in memoriams
- Members** – click to see group members or search for friends and colleagues
- Events** – click to see current social events, or once in this section, click '+Create Event' to share your own event with other retirees
- Photos** – click to see photos or videos posted by group members
- Files** – click to access files that are uploaded to the site. Files are listed from newest to oldest, so scan the list for:
 - RAC contact information
 - Retiree Volunteer Program
 - AGA wallet card
 - Employee Banking Offer
 - Past retirements and in memoriams
 - CIBC retiree social group contact information
 - Pension Annual Reports
 - WorkPerks® at CIBC
 - CIBC Wellness Checkpoint
 - Retiree social group subsidy
 - And much more!
- 4 **Write Post** – click to share a story with group members; this is a great way to catch up with former colleagues
- Add Photo / Video** – click to share a photo with group members; fellow retirees will be interested in photos of times at CIBC or retirement events
- Ask Question** – click to ask a question, to be answered by group members
