Additional maximum limits

- For Small Business clients: \$100,000 CAD within 24 hours to most countries.
- For GMTs to China, the funds are delivered in CNY or USD depending on the transfer method:
 - To a China UnionPay card, you can send up to \$3,000 CAD per transaction.
 - To an Alipay account, you can send up to \$8,000 CAD per transaction.
 - Note: The Government of the People's Republic of China enforces the following additional limits when someone sends money to a China UnionPay card: a recipient in mainland China can receive a maximum amount of 50,000 USD yearly from any source.
- For cash pickup transfers to Pakistan, the limit is \$999 per transaction.
- The following additional countries have a maximum of \$75,000 CAD per day (for small business, maximum of \$100,000 CAD per day) and the following limits per each transaction:
