- Future date tax payments to the payment due date for accurate cash flow forecasting

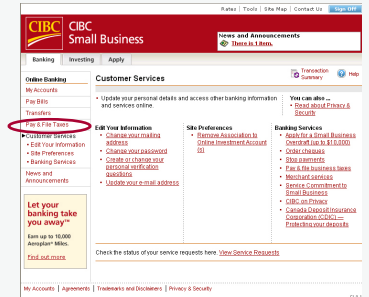
TIP: Do you want to simplify your cash management?

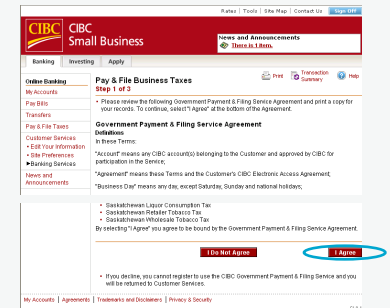
Register for CIBC GPFS in 3 Easy Steps
